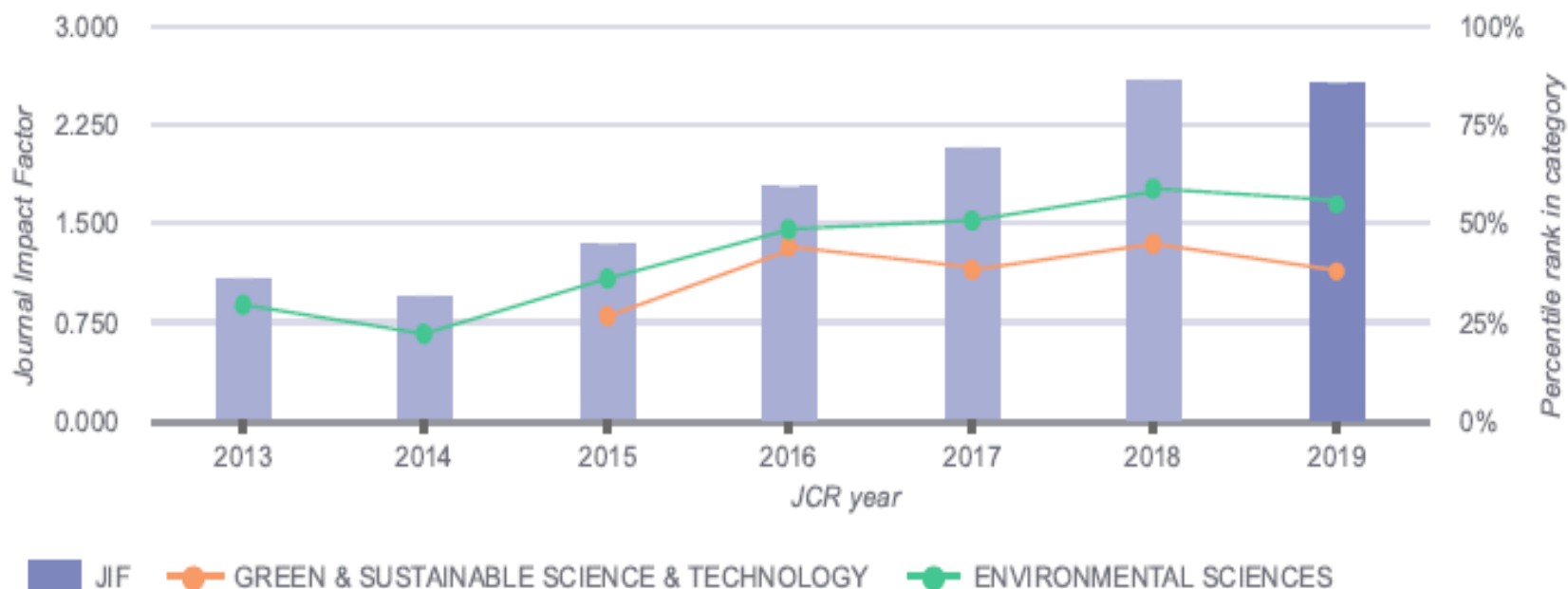

  2. **Regulatory measures**, already implemented or proposed for the future, that will contribute **to align new mobility trends with sustainable development goals**

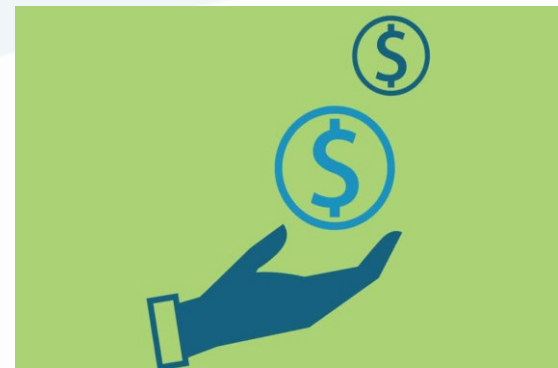
